This judging form is to be used for Chevrolet and GMC vehicles that have had limited exterior modifications consistent with the judging guidelines established by the Personalized Chevrolet Chapter. Personalized class judging is divided into 4 areas: interior, exterior, engine compartment and chassis. Judging is based on workmanship, condition and cleanliness. The PCC Class is determined by the extent to which the vehicle has been personalized. The judge will use this form to enter the amount of points to be deducted per item along with a brief description of the reason for the deductions. Rules: Vehicle must have a Chevrolet body and motor. Mandatory for all vehicles to have an approved, visible fire extinguisher at all times.

GUIDANCE FOR VEHICLE MODIFICATIONS

EXTERIOR:	
1 Custom paint	Non-standard paint color with clear coat for reflective quality.
2 Additional paint effects	Metal flake/pearlescent paint/ghost flames or ghost stripes.
ENGINE BAY	
1 Upgraded engine/cross model	Replacing an engine with another of a larger physical dimensions not designed into the engine bay. For example, installing a six-cylinder engine in a pre-1929 car or truck, a small block V8 into a pre-1955 car, truck or Corvette or pre-1964 Nova; or installing a big block V8 into a pre-1958 car or pre-1965 Corvette or Chevelle or pre-1968 pickup or pre-1969 Nova. Such installations often involve design and fabrication challenges.
	Countable in any model or year is any modern fuel-injected, supercharged or turbocharged engine replacement or any specialty crate engine designated as LSX, 427 CHEVROLET, 502 CHEVROLET or 572 CHEVROLET on the valve covers. Such installations generally add visual enhancements to the engine bay.
2 Engine dress-up/minimum 3 items	At least 3 of the following: chrome valve covers, chrome air cleaner, polished aluminum or multi-carb intake, chrome power steering/alternator/battery cover/master cylinder, coated exhaust manifolds, hose/clamp cover kits, provided none were stock components.
3 Radiator module	Stainless/aluminum "show" module extending to inner fenders or well-designed smaller "show" radiator.
INTERIOR	
1 Redesigned front seat	Bucket seats (if not stock or optional) or otherwise resculpted seat.
2 Redesigned rear seat	Bucket seats (if not stock or optional) or otherwise resculpted seat.
3 Upgraded seat covering	At least front & rear seats (if present) covered in upscale material like leather.
4 Custom integrated console	Appears "built-in" to interior & not standard equipment or optional. Must contain at least two of the following integrated controls: shifter, radio, power window/door switches, lighting, speakers or A/C vents. Aftermarket "stick-on" types are not countable.
5 Aftermarket integrated gauges	At least two aftermarket <u>in-dash</u> gauges, such as speedometer, tachometer, oil pressure, water temp, fuel, volts, vacuum. Under dash gauges are not countable.
6 Aftermarket integrated A/C	At least two in-dash vents on opposite side of dash with separately-located controls. Single under-dash units are not countable.
CHASSIS	
1 Custom wheels	Aftermarket custom wheels. Regular production "mag" wheels and rally-style wheels are countable if not standard equipment or optional. Custom hubcaps (e.g., spinners) or painted stock-style wheels are not countable.
2 Custom "show" chassis	Fully "show" chassis typically including painted frame/axles, stainless components (e.g., gas tank, exhaust & fuel/brake lines) and chrome suspension components. A "partly" show-appearing chassis is not countable.
